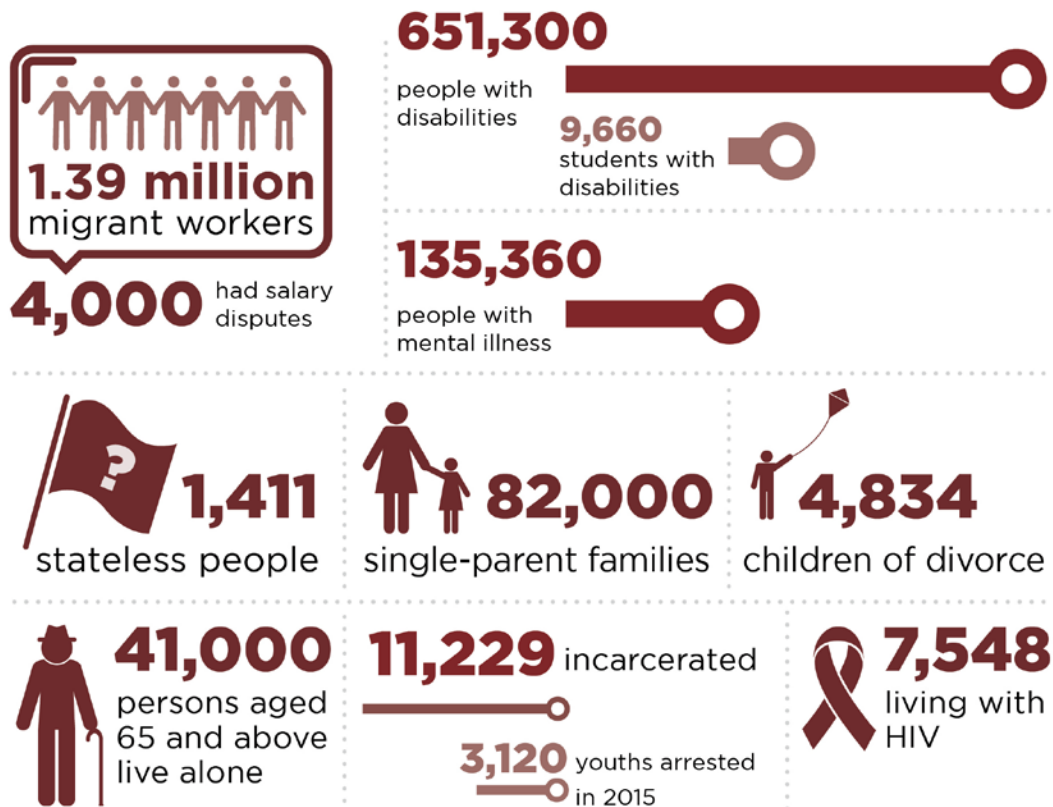


Fig 1. Infographic of statistics on various vulnerable groups in Singapore
