<p>ComCare Student Care Subsidies</p> <p>For more information, please visit: here</p>	<p>Monthly subsidy depends on monthly household income (tiered so that lower income families receive more assistance)</p> <p>Independent of the one-off Start-Up Grant (\$400 per child) <i>This grant can be used to pay for the initial costs such as deposits, registration fees, uniforms and insurance.</i></p>	<p>Both spouses work at least 56 hours per month*</p> <p>Total gross monthly household income is \$4,000 or less, or per capita income is \$1,000 or less</p> <p>Child is 7-14 years old and attends a registered Student Care Centre</p> <p>Child is a Singapore Citizen or Permanent Resident (at least one immediate family member in the same household must be a Singapore Citizen)</p> <p>Also available for children with disabilities in special student care centres - please refer to SG Enable for more information</p> <p>*if either party is not working at least 56 hours per month, s/he will need to have valid reasons with documentary proof (e.g. looking for work, medical leave, certified full-time caregiver for a dependent, etc.)</p>	<p>Application forms available at any registered student care (refer here for details)</p> <p>Required documents:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Copy of child's birth certificate 2. Copy of both parents' updated NRIC (or NRIC of child's guardian and proof of guardianship, if possible) 3. Latest copy of both parents' pay slips or a letter from employers stating both parents' monthly income
<p>Comcare Child Care Subsidies</p>	<p>Financial assistance for low-income families who are unable to afford childcare fees even after the Basic and Additional Subsidies</p>	<p>Child is a Singapore citizen</p> <p>Both spouses work at least 56 hours per month or produce valid reasons for not working (such as he/she is on medical leave, under incarceration)</p>	<p>Application can be made at licensed child care centres</p>

<p>PCF Headstart Fund (HSF) PAP Community Foundation</p>	<p>The HSF helps young Pre-school children (nursery to K2) have a headstart in life through good grounding in their early education.</p> <p>The grant can be used to pay school fees, buy uniforms/books and for pocket money. This is to help ease the financial burden faced by parents.</p> <p>Two types of Assistance Available:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Successful applicants will receive \$50 a month up to a maximum of \$600 a year 2. Successful applicants who have special needs (eg, hearing/visually impaired, autistic, Down Syndrome) will receive \$100 a month up to a maximum of \$1,200 a year 	<p>Child must be a Singapore citizen</p> <p>Child must be between 4 to 10 years old</p> <p>At least one parent must be a Singapore Citizen</p> <p>The child must be enrolled in PCF Kindergarten/ Childcare Centre/Student Care Centre/primary school/special needs school that is registered with either MSF or MOE</p> <p>Net per capita income is less than or equal to \$500</p> <p>For special needs cases, child must be attending a therapy programme in a hospital, special schools or agencies that are registered with MOH, MSF or MOE.</p> <p>School Attendance: Child must have regular attendance records. <p>Basic Infant & Childcare Subsidy ECDA</p>	<p>If you are a working mother:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Basic subsidy for infant care: \$600 - Basic subsidy for child care: \$300 <p>If you are a non-working mother:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Basic subsidy for infant care: \$150 - Basic subsidy for child care: \$150 <p><i>Subsidy amounts stated above are for full day programmes only.</i></p>	<p>Child is a Singapore citizen</p> <p>Child is enrolled in an ECDA-licensed infant care / child care centre in Singapore</p>	<p>Application form is available here</p>
