<p><b>Kindergarten Financial Assistance Scheme (KiFAS)</b></p> <p>Early Childhood Development Agency (ECDA)</p>	<p>Helps needy parents from lower income families pay for school fees for their children who attend qualifying MOE or Anchor Operator kindergartens</p> <p>Assistance rates are tiered according to gross monthly household income, with lower income families receiving more</p> <p><u><a href="#">Refer here for KiFAS assistance rates</a></u></p> <p>Payment will be disbursed directly to the child's kindergarten</p>	<p>Child must be a Singapore Citizen</p> <p>Child must be enrolled in kindergartens operated by Anchor Operators or MOE</p> <p>Gross monthly household income is \$6,000 or below and/or for larger families, the per capita is \$1,500 and below</p> <p>Adopted children are eligible as long as parents have an Adoption Order and the child's birth certificate, and the child is a Singapore Citizen (subject to the other eligibility criteria)</p>	<p>Applications may be made at the child's kindergarten</p> <p>Required supporting documents:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Parents' NRICs</li> <li>2. Child's birth certificate or Certificate of Citizenship</li> <li>3.
